Finally, a fresh-faced, youthful glow like Eva Longoria's is achievable in a flash — without Botox needles. By targeting both the inner and outer layers of skin, the new Affirm laser rids users of everything from wrinkles and saggy folds to large pores and acne scars.

A one-stop shop

The latest version of the Affirm laser, NYC cosmetic dermatologist Dr. Steven Victor explains, uses two wavelengths. The first creates microcuts in the

outer layer of skin that, when healed, tighten skin and promote collagen formation. The second heats the lower layer of skin, causing it to contract and look firmer.

Pretty — and pain-free!

The Affirm even has a built-in cooling mechanism to dull pain and reduce redness in up to five days. The process requires a round of four to six 15-to-20-minute treatments (\$1,000 each) every two weeks and one session every six months after that for maintenance. Says Dr. Victor, "It's a quick fix."



The Affirm undoes sun damage in a zap and prevents new problems from surfacing.
